

Job Purpose

Job Summary

- Work with the PE Lead in delivering outstanding PE and school sport provision in curriculum and out of . curriculum time for all pupils.
- Evaluate performance, strengths, and weaknesses and provide suitable feedback with positivity, motivation, . and signposting pupils to external clubs to support their development.
- Encourage pupils to gain and develop skills, knowledge, and techniques. .
- Ensure pupils perform to a high standard of health and safety at all times. .

Job Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Support for the School

- Lead groups of children, under the direction of the PE Lead, for PE activities.
- Team teach with PE colleagues when necessary.
- Assist pupils to develop basic PE skills and provide differentiation for all abilities in lessons.
- Lead extra-curricular activities after school.
- Organise and maintain the learning environment under the direction of the PE Lead.
- Use knowledge and skills (e.g. PE, literacy, numeracy, and science) to contribute to pupil learning as directed.
- Work with the PE Lead and contribute to planning.
- Record pupil activities and achievements as directed, including assessment.
- Support the PE Lead and/or teacher by accompanying pupils on off-site fixtures.
- In conjunction with the PE Lead, organise fixtures as required.
- Organise and deliver inter-school competition.
- Assist with the preparation of equipment and display boards.
- Assist with changing and personal care.
- Support the PE Lead with any tasks which are required.
- Work as part of a team to ensure the wellbeing, behaviour, and personal development of pupils.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- · Understand and assist in interpretation of school policies.
- Comply with safeguarding protocols and demonstrate at all times.
- Support the maintenance and enhancement of the school's ethos and mission through your own outstanding professional conduct and high expectations of others.
